

Need a Ride to the Bus Stop?

Book a Ride with First Mile Last Mile

St. Lawrence County Public Transit and Volunteer Transportation Center team up to bring you the First Mile Last Mile (FMLM) program: A way to connect riders with the bus.

How does it work?

1. Call

At least two business days in advance, call 315-644-6944 between Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. to arrange a ride.

2. Ride

Catch a ride with your volunteer driver to the bus stop.

3. Connect

Ride the bus to and from your destination for \$2 each way.

4. Return

Meet your volunteer driver at the bus stop and complete your trip with them.

Note: FMLM trips may be requested for any time that a bus is available for a connection. Trips requested to begin before 6:00 a.m. or after 7:00 p.m. will be dependent on volunteer driver availability.



First Mile Last Mile Fast Facts



All First Mile Last Mile trips must connect to a bus.

FMLM is available anytime SLC Public Transportation (the bus) is available. See schedules here: <u>www.slcnypublictransit.com</u>

Ride with FMLM to connect to the bus that will get you where you need to go.

Anyone can ride with FMLM.

Use FMLM for one-way or round trips.

Rides are unlimited as long as program funding is available.

All rides can be fully accessible.

All trips must be booked at least two business days in advance. Same day trips are not available.
